



# How Secure is SecureLine?

As a user of SecureLine, you can make adjustments to your settings to get the right level of security and usability for your needs. SecureLine has four “levels” of security:

## Level 1 Description:

- You store your certificate on our server.
- You Escrow your certificate password on our server.

### You get:

- All SecureLine features.
- Retrieval for lost certificate passwords.

### This means:

- You trust LuxSci to hold all of your security information.

## Level 2 Description:

- You store your certificate on our server.
- Your certificate password is not saved with us.

### You get:

- All SecureLine features except for inbound auto-decryption.
- No retrieval for lost certificate passwords.

### This means:

- LuxSci only stores your secure certificate, but not its password.
- Your password is on our server only temporarily when you decrypt a message in WebMail. It is then discarded.

### Level 3 Description:

- You store your certificate in your email program.

#### You get:

- SecureLine Escrow and SecureSend features.
- (Auto-)Encryption for outbound messages.
- No inbound auto-decryption or decryption in WebMail.

#### This means:

- You get the maximum security; LuxSci does not store any of your security information.
- You can send and receive secure messages, but cannot read them in WebMail, only in your email client.

### Level 4 Description:

- You do not use any certificates.

#### You get:

- SecureSend and Escrow features.
- (Auto-)Encryption for outbound messages.

#### This means:

- You can still securely communicate with anyone, but you can only view received encrypted messages in the Escrow Portal.
